- You have Medicare Part A and days available in your benefit period.
- You have a qualifying hospital stay of three or more consecutive overnights.
- Your doctor orders services for Rehabilitation and Skilled Nursing care to be provided by a skilled professional such as a registered nurse, physical, occupational, or speech therapist, etc.
- You require skilled care on a daily basis.
- You need reasonable, necessary skilled services for diagnosis or treatment of a medical condition.

How much of your stay may be covered by Medicare?

Days 1–20 100%

Days 21–100 Daily copayment applies

If you have a Medicare supplemental plan or secondary insurance policy, your policy may pay all of your daily copayment.
